Last year, we cared for 40,000 of our neighbors and friends across more than 144,000 patient visits to our hospital and outpatient clinics. We're recognized by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services as a Five-Star health system, a designation held by only 358 hospitals in the U.S. This puts us in the top 12%. Sage Living, our senior living community, consistently earns Five Stars as well.

What makes us different is a simple but powerful belief: that care doesn't begin or end at our front door. From the wages we pay to the businesses we support, from workforce housing to childcare, every investment we make reflects our commitment to this place and the people who call it home. It's how we do our part to make sure our extraordinary community has what it needs to thrive.

We bring a depth of specialty care that few communities our size can claim.

Strong primary care is the foundation of any community health system, and our Family Medicine & Pediatrics, Internal Medicine, and Urgent Care teams serve thousands of patients every year. But across our nearly two dozen outpatient clinics, we've built something rarely found in communities our size. Patients can see specialists in oncology, cardiology, pulmonology, urology, general surgery, psychiatry, gastroenterology, ENT, orthopedic trauma surgery, OB/GYN, and more.

That means our families and friends can be treated close to home—reducing travel burdens and delays in treatment. This supports earlier diagnoses, better outcomes, and a healthier community overall.

### ***St. John's Health Wages and Benefits***

As the largest year-round employer in Teton County, WY, St. John's Health paid \$120 million in compensation last year to more than 850 healthcare workers who keep our health system open 24/7, every day of the year. These wages and benefits support local families, increase household stability, and drive spending at local businesses. The hospital's payroll helps sustain community jobs beyond healthcare, including retail, construction trades, hospitality, and professional services.

### ***Dollars Spent with Local Businesses***

We rely on local businesses to help deliver on our mission. Last year, we paid more than \$9 million directly to Teton County vendors for a multitude of diverse products and services, including construction and other trades, media, hospitality, retail, and professional services. These payments keep dollars circulating throughout Teton County, strengthening the local economy and supporting jobs across multiple sectors.

We partner with community organizations to support vulnerable populations.

### ***Partnering with Nonprofits***

We recognize that some of our neighbors face unique challenges accessing healthcare, and we do our part to help. We partner with the Teton Free Clinic, a valued local resource for uninsured people in the community. In addition to the low-cost clinic lease, we provide diagnostic imaging and laboratory services to the clinic's patients at no cost. Last year, this support amounted to \$404,338 in care.

We value all our nonprofit partnerships with agencies that support vulnerable populations, including Teton Youth & Family Services, Voices JH, Community Safety Network, Teton County Search & Rescue, Mental Health & Recovery Services of Jackson Hole, and others.

### ***Workforce Housing Subsidy***

Our annual subsidy for St. John's Health housing allows us to offer our units at a 36% average discount from market rates. This helps keep rates low, currently ranging from \$1,658 for one-bedroom units to \$2,858 for three-bedroom units. We provide housing to team members through 85 rental units, and we are constructing 72 units at the Hitching Post Apartments. These efforts help with recruitment and retention of essential healthcare workers in a high-cost community, ensuring consistent access to high-quality care.



## INVESTING IN OUR PEOPLE

Our subsidized childcare program allows local healthcare workers to show up for their families and for yours.

### ***Childcare Services and Subsidy***

Our annual subsidy for our childcare program helps keep employee rates 40% lower than typical Jackson rates. This subsidy helps our employees, who often work 12-hour shifts, find reliable care while they are taking care of the community's healthcare needs. By stabilizing working families, we contribute to a stronger, more resilient community overall.

### ***Uncompensated Care***

Last year, St. John's Health provided more than \$14.3 million in uncompensated care. By caring for people regardless of their ability to pay, we help prevent delayed treatment, reducing the severity of illness and the need for more costly emergency care. SJH Foundation helps provide assistance to patients and families facing financial hardship, lowering barriers to care and healing. Overall, our efforts strengthen public health and contribute to a safer, more stable community.

### ***Health Education and Screenings***

Last year, we provided more than \$118,000 worth of free health talks and screenings, covering topics such as heart and lung health, colon health, cancer prevention, healthy aging, joint and spine surgery, and more. This outreach can lead to earlier access to care, better outcomes, and a healthier overall population.

Our signature outreach event is the Healthy Living Fest, held with the Teton County Health Department and the Rec Center to reach people who have limited access to care. Last year, more than 200 people received free screenings for hearing, diabetes, dental health, skin cancer, blood pressure, STIs, and concussions.

Care, for us, has never been a transaction. It's a relationship, with our patients, with our neighbors, with the place we all call home.

Every figure in these pages is really a story about people: the caregivers who show up, the families who count on us, and the local businesses and nonprofits we partner with to keep this community strong.

*None of this would be possible without the generosity of donors who invest in the health of our community through SJH Foundation. Philanthropy fills the gaps that reimbursement and tax revenue cannot, funding the programs, equipment, and access to care that Teton County depends on.
